An overview of some of the work IOP undertakes will be given, along with the journals and services available from IOP Publishing.


In particular, management of the peer-review process for *Journal of Physics B: Atomic, Molecular and Optical Physics* will be discussed

Led by Editor-in-Chief, Jan-Michael Rost and Deputy Editor Paul Corkum, *Journal of Physics B: Atomic, Molecular and Optical Physics* is an established international journal, committed for the past 42 years to publishing high-quality research across all areas of atomic, molecular and optical physics.

Papers are published under the following sections:

- Atomic Physics
- Molecular and Cluster Structure, Properties and Dynamics
- Atomic and Molecular Collisions
- Cold Matter
- Optical and Laser Physics
- Quantum Optics, Information and Control
- Ultrafast, High-Field, and X-Ray Physics
- Astrophysics and Plasma Physics

We have a team dedicated to making sure the peerreview process runs as smoothly as possible, and in 2008 our median time from submission to webpublication was just 97 days for Papers and 49 days for Fast Track Communications. (Fig. 1)
